



HIV/STI PREVENTION RESOURCES:

A BILLING CODE REFERENCE

Descriptions provided for ICD-10-CM and CPT codes are taken from the *2022 ICD-10-CM Expert for Hospitals*, the *2022 CPT® Professional Edition*, and the *IPHA Billing Manual for HIV Testing and Related Services*. This information may be a resource when providing HIV and other STI prevention and diagnostic services, and when submitting insurance claims* for reimbursement for these important services.

USPSTF:

U.S. Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF) issued a Grade A recommendation for PrEP medication and ancillary services.

ACA:

As a result of the USPSTF Grade A recommendation, the Affordable Care Act (ACA) requires most plans to cover certain PrEP medications and ancillary services with no out-of-pocket costs.

USE OF MODIFIER 33*:

In response to the ACA, the AMA developed Modifier 33.

- Modifier 33 is only applicable to individuals with commercial plans (eg, not applicable to Medicare and Medicaid plans)
- Modifier 33 informs the payer that the service is recommended by the USPSTF with an “A” or “B” rating
- No co-pay or deductible should be applied to a service with a USPSTF “A” or “B” rating, based on current recommendations
- Modifier 33 may be appended to all appropriate *CPT*[®] codes not already designated as prevention services

New Patient —evaluation and management, which requires a medically appropriate history and/or examination and medical decision-making (document and bill based on time and complexity)	99202 - 99205
