Descriptions provided for ICD-10-CM and CPT® codes are taken from the American Medical Association *ICD-10-CM 2025: The Complete Official Codebook*, and the *IPHA Billing Manual for HIV Testing and Related Services*. This information may be a resource when providing HIV and other STI prevention and diagnostic services, and when submitting insurance claims\* for reimbursement for these important services.

<b>Established Patient—synchronous audio-only telehealth</b> evaluation and management, which requires a medically appropriate history and/or examination and medical decision-making (document and bill based on time and complexity)	98012-98015

Emergency department visit for the evaluation and management of a patient, which requires a medically appropriate history and/or examination (document and bill based on level of medical decision-making)	99282 - 99285

<b>New or Established Patient—preventive medicine counseling</b> and/or risk factor reduction intervention(s) provided to an individual (document and bill based on visit time)	<b>99401 - 99404</b>
